#### Tiny Happy People

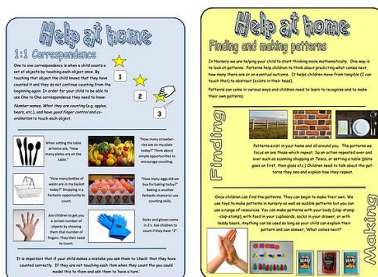


Tiny Happy People website has been published by the BBC in order to support parents to develop children's communication skills. Parents can choose their child's age band to access a range of activities and play ideas.
